Notice is hereby given that, having caused a local Hearing to be held, the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs has decided to confirm the above Order.

The effect of the Order as confirmed is to modify the Definitive Map and Statement for the area by adding a restricted byway from the county road east of Prince's Gate and Bridge, along a generally defined lane to and through Shortacombe, and upgrading part of Footpath No. 20, East Down, to restricted byway between Shortacombe and the county road, Dudmoor Lane at Shortacombe Corner, in the parish of East Down, and administrative district of North Devon.

A copy of the Order and the Order map may be seen free of charge at the Public Rights of Way Service, Lucombe House, County Hall, Exeter, and at the North Devon Council offices, Lynton House, Commercial Road, Barnstaple, between 9.30 a.m. and 4 p.m. Monday – Friday, online at www.devon.gov.uk/haveyoursay, or by appointment with the Parish Clerk.

An application for any of the reasons stated in Paragraph 12(1) of Schedule 15 of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 may be made to the High Court to quash the Order within 42 days of the date of publication of this Notice.
