

East Down Parish Council - 31st May 2020

Following the government's guidance East Parish Council has not met during the months of April and May but with delegated powers approved at the March meeting payments have been made.

Coronavirus. All the emails received relating to the coronavirus from many sources have been forwarded to councillors and to the editor of the East Down and Arlington newsletter. The large volume of coronavirus material being sent was considered inappropriate to be included in the newsletter and a separate monthly 'coronavirus information sheet' was prepared. This was emailed and posted out to those not currently on the circulation list.

Once completed the Parish Council will meet by video/telephone to approve the accounts, sign the Certificate of Exemption and forward it to the External Auditor. This has to be done by 30th June. Once the paperwork is ready a meeting will be organised.


